Please help us encourage plenty of reading over the summer! :) Summer reading helps children actively continue building reading skills and is one key to preparing for a new school year.

Schedule a simple time to read, or in a special place, such as in a hammock each morning, on the beach, at the park, in the backyard, or in bed each evening! You could get your children together for weekly book clubs and snacks! Be sure to visit the Aiken Library for plenty of additional print and digital books for summer reading too!

To provide an incentive for this optional summer reading, SMS will offer tiered rewards for the number of pages read over the summer, individually and class-wide. Please see the table below for individual rewards. The class-wide rewards will consist of an extra recess earned for the class with the highest number of pages read in each of the K-2, 3-5, and 6-8th grade categories, and a pizza party for the class with the highest number of summer reading AR points in each of the grade level categories. *Be sure to return the attached summer reading log during the first week back to school with total pages read added up and a parent signature!*
